We had a busy year starting with corn sale and the youth ice fishing day. This was the first year of having a school trap team using our range from late February until late May. We hosted two school youth shoots with teams from other towns. There will be another youth team in 2026. The trap team had a benefit shoot to help fund the team. We also had the Ed Bailey Memorial shoot in the fall that benefits the club and trap range. The Drum and Henry fishing derby was in June with approximately 150 youth in attendance.

Some club improvements we did this year: We purchased six new picnic tables to match the newer tables we have. Six more need replacement. We put a partial ceiling under the pavilion and plan on continuing with that in the future. We also had to do some work on the kitchen sink drain system.

I would like to thank all the volunteers for your help and our members that help finance our club. Without you the club could not be what it is.
